Dear Parent/Carer,

Following our very successful trip to Beaumanor Hall (that saw the children empathising with evacuees) we wish to continue providing the children with 'real life' experiences in order to more effectively deliver the curriculum. With this in mind, we have planned another trip that will develop the children's learning in RE, of Judaism, and in particular how many Jewish children escaped persecution from the Nazis via the Kindertransport. This is obviously an emotive part of the curriculum and one that we understand needs to be taught sensitively. In order to help us achieve this we plan to take the Year 6 to the National Holocaust Centre on **Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> October**.

The National Holocaust Centre and Museum promotes an understanding of the roots of discrimination and prejudice, and the development of ethical values, leading to a greater understanding within society. The Centre uses the history of genocide as a model of how society can break down, and emphasises how current and future generations must carefully examine and learn from these tragedies. The Centre promotes respect for human rights, equal opportunities and good citizenship, which has greater resonance than ever in our culturally diverse society.

During the trip, the children will be working with their class and an educator from the Centre. We will be going on the Journey Learning Programme in the morning. The exhibition tells the stories of Jewish children who lived during the 1930s and Second World War, and who survived.

After lunch, we will be listening to a survivor of the Holocaust.

We will be leaving school after registration and will be returning in time for the end of the school day.

We kindly request that a payment of £12 per child be made to ipayimpact prior to the trip and any questions regarding the trip please do ask the Year 6 team.
