Trim Trail before and after school

We have recently received a complaint regarding junior school children playing on the infants' trim trail and gathering in groups on or near the playground, which some of the smaller infant children find distressing and worrying. This culminated in an incident during the week when a small child was hurt with a stick and some of the children around were unkind.

In order to keep both our children and the infant children safe and happy, if you are waiting for your child to come out of juniors and you have a younger sibling with you, they need to remain with you and not play on the Junior school equipment please. We would again remind you that equipment in either school should not be used before or after school by any children, in order to comply with our school risk assessments and insurance policy, as they cannot be supervised by a member of staff. We have reminded the children of this in school too.

Likewise, if you are waiting in the Infant playground, please make sure older siblings stay with you and do not play on their play equipment. If your child walks home alone or with their friends please do remind them of this, there is not reason for them to be in the infant school playground at all in some cases.

We want to keep our children and families both at the Infants and Juniors, safe and happy in and around school and we know you will support us with this.
