On Wednesday 13th October I was fortunate enough to be able to accompany year 6 on their trip to the Holocaust Centre. We took part in 'The Journey', a sensitively implemented tour of several rooms each of which was designed to represent a different time period in the life of Leo, a Jewish boy growing up in Nazi Germany, culminating in his journey on the Kindertransport and his life as a refugee in England.

The children asked pertinent questions and our educator was impressed with their level of background knowledge.

Each child later had the opportunity to select a stone and place it on a memorial which is being built over time as a tribute to each of the 1.5 million children who perished during the Holocaust.

The children behaved in a respectful and mature manner throughout the day - they were complimented on their behaviour by the organisers, and I was proud to be associated with the school.
