Pupils: How we need you to help us re-open school safely



No school if there are ANY symptoms in your home.



No need to wear uniform: Clean clothes every day.



Bring your own water-bottle each day.



No other personal belongings or books to travel to / from school.




Stay 2m away from your school adult.



Follow our hygiene expectations.



Follow instructions given by your school adult.



Be on time



Keep your distance when you use the outside space.



Stay in your own learning space.



Obey the special signs and markings around school.

Doing this will keep all families safe.



Talk to us if you are feeling worried about something.

How we are keeping you safe in school

You will be in a bubble not a class.

Your bubble will not mix with children from any other bubble at all during school hours. This means that if there is an infection in one bubble, all other bubbles are protected.

Your bubble will have:

- It's own start time
- It's own teacher or teaching assistant
- It's own handwashing facilities and hand sanitizer
- It's own lunch time (packed lunches in their own classroom) Key Worker group only
- It's own midday break supervisor Key worker group only
- It's own home time

In your bubble you should:

- Stay in your own learning space
- Only use the books, stationery and resources you have been given
- Wash your hands as soon as you re-enter the classroom
- Wash your hands after you have been to the toilet or outside
- Have your own 'bubble' break-times, in the area allocated to you Not Y6

The adult in your bubble will:

- Answer any questions you have
- Reassure you if you have worries
- Provide you with appropriate learning activities and resources
- Remind you about strategies for staying safe and healthy
- Make sure your bubble is cleaned regularly
