## Contact Tracing over the Christmas Holiday

#### Contacting the School about COVID-19 during the Christmas Holiday

We sincerely hope that all families have a healthy and COVID-19-free Christmas break. However, we recommend all parents and carers are aware of the following information and relevant arrangements regarding positive cases in the Christmas holidays:

- Where a pupil tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school **should not** be contacted. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.
- Up to and including Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> December, if a pupil tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms on either Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> December or Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> December, please report the case to school. Using the following email address:

Correspondence to this email address will be monitored daily. The school will assist Public Health England and the Department for Education in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.
