Dear Parents/Carers

It won't be long until Westdale Wraparound launches on Thursday September 3rd and we would like to update you on some details for the club.

Staffing

We are delighted to announce that our club will be supervised by Tracey Payne and Julie Doherty, former Woodpeckers staff and very familiar with our Westdale Junior School pupils. They have been very excited about helping to establish our new provision and have lots of wonderful ideas plus experience by the bucketload! They will be assisted by Jayne Elvin and Norma Birch who already work in school as midday supervisors.

Covid-19 Safety Measures

Initially our wraparound pupils will be split into lower school (Y3 & Y4) and upper school (Y5 & Y6) bubbles in line with our wider risk assessment regarding full school re-opening. The lower school will be based in the school hall and the upper school will be based in the dining hall, this mirrors our lunchtime arrangements during the school day. We will continually review this situation and our hope is that it won't be too long before all year groups will be based in the dining hall. Obviously pupils will spend lots of time playing outdoors and we have had an exciting new tyre park installed for that very purpose!



All of the precautions we have in place during the school day will apply to Wraparound with children having continuous access to handwashing/cleansing facilities and social distancing adhered to. There has been careful planning around appropriate activities and how resources will be shared within groups.

Booking your sessions

Most of you will have now completed your booking forms for the Autumn Term. Please ensure that you give 7 days' notice if you wish to change prebooked sessions.

Drop off and pick up

Please come to the fire exit door in the staff car park, if the door is closed ring the doorbell.

PLEASE DO NOT PULL INTO/PARK IN THE STAFF CAR PARK, EVEN IF THERE ARE EMPTY SPACES!

It is very important that we keep movement of vehicles to a minimum at Wraparound drop off and pick up times.

Nutrition

We will be offering a breakfast of cereal and toast with various toppings and healthy snacks after school such as a selection of fresh fruit, wraps, veg sticks, cheese, ham, quorn, rice cakes, pittas etc. The food we provide at after-school club is not intended as a substitute for a main evening meal.

What your child needs to bring

Your child will keep their coats and bags with them at Wraparound, they will not be permitted to go to their classroom to drop off or collect items. If your child uses an inhaler then they must carry this in their school bag so that it is readily accessible. Phones and electronic games are not permitted.
